

Simply Sent Card Elements Box

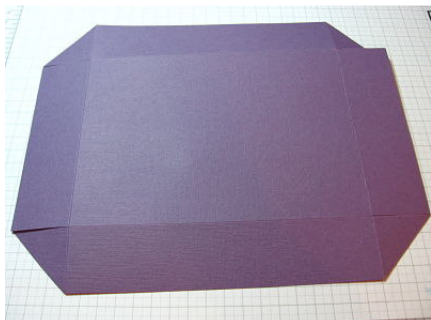
You will need:

- Simply Sent Card Elements Flower Power or similar
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Sticky Strip
- Mini Glue Dots
- Corner Rounder punch

Here's How:



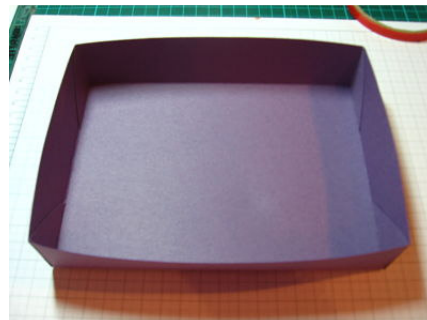
Take two pieces of cardstock from the kit and cut both pieces 8" x 10". Score 1 1/2" in from each edge on both pieces.



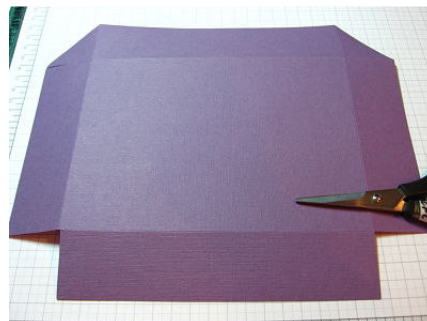
For the base, snip into each end as far as the intersecting score line. Trim the corners off diagonally, this eliminates any uneven pieces which may stick above the rim of the box.



Attach sticky strip across the corners, as shown.



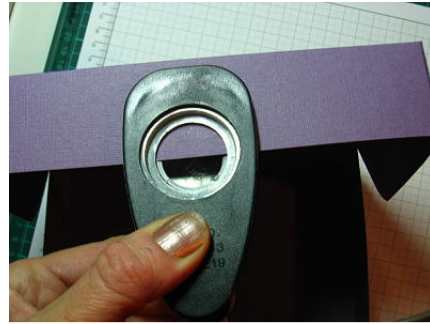
Fold in the corners, and fold up the ends and seal to make the box base.



Trim the two front corners of the lid as previous with the base, but cut out the two back corners.



Place tape across end flap as shown, this will adhere to the inside wall of the base. Place tape on the corners, tuck to the inside of the lid, fold up the sides and adhere.



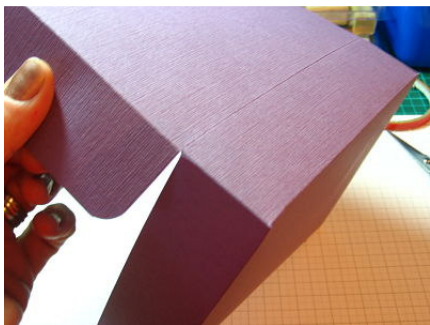
Mark the centre of the front flap on the box. With a 1' circle punch (or circle punch of choice) punch out a semi circle.



Round off the rear corners of the lid with the corner rounder punch.



Close the lid – now to decorate the box!



Remove tape backing and adhere back flap of lid to the inside back of the base.



Cut a piece of the coordinating DSP 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and adhere to the lid of the box.



Decorate the box as desired, using the elements from the kit.

TIP:

Use an embossing buddy on the back of die cuts if using as a raised element. The powder takes the stickiness off the back and Stampin' Dimensionals can still be used to raise the image.
